The successful applicant will be available to operate the Vancouver Waldorf School's parent/child Parent and Tot program running Saturday mornings for 30-33 sessions from September 2010 to June 2011. The teacher must be able to smoothly and calmly facilitate a group of children in play, and be able to work with and coach adults. The teacher must have an excellent understanding of Waldorf education, be trained and experienced in Waldorf early childhood education, preferably with experience in the VWS programs, and have a good foundation in the Anthroposophical view of the human being and child development, and yet be able to express these ideas in language that parents new to these ideas can understand. New parents need sensible and practical answers that are not experienced as dogmatic or prosthelytizing.

Our school, now in its 40th year, offers a full Early Childhood to Grade Twelve program. Our newly completed and anthroposophically designed Early Childhood Centre houses our Early Childhood programs. Our current site development plan includes completing the construction of the remaining buildings on one campus, including the Grade School, High School and Performing Hall. We operate on a three-fold governance structure.

Remuneration The Contractor will receive a flat fee of \$100 per session worked plus a flat fee of \$400 for all 30-33 sessions to be used for the purchase of supplies and food.
